How To Make Mn Tax Payments Online For Your Business

There have been many questions on how to make MN Tax payments. Whether or not you are making a payment due with the return or an estimated tax payment, the instructions are similar. Log into your MN e-Services account, note that MN requires that all payments be made electronically.

- Once logged into your account, choose either S-Corp Tax or Partnership Tax (this will coincide with the type of tax return that is being filed).
- Click on "Make a Payment" on the right hand column.
- On the next screen choose year you are paying for.
- In the next box choose whether it is an estimated payment or payment due with return in the drop down box.
- Enter dollar amount.
- Choose date you want payment taken out of your bank account, usually you can just use due date of the payment.

Make sure to print the confirmation once it is completed. It is recommended to log in a couple days before the due date to ensure that MN processes it timely. If there are any questions, please reach out to us.

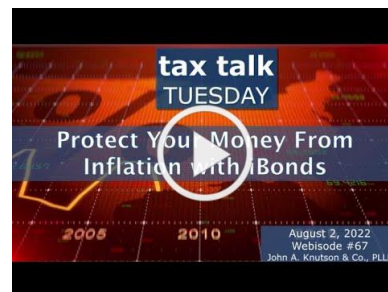
