Minnesota Minimum Wage Rate Increase for 2024

Beginning on January 1, 2024, large employers will need to pay employees at least \$10.85 per hour and small employers will need to pay employees at least \$8.85 per hour.

<u>Training wage rate</u>: For employees younger than 20 years of age, employers may pay a wage as low as \$8.85 for the first 90 consecutive days of employment.

<u>Youth wage rate</u>: For employees younger than 18 years of age, employers may pay a wage as low as \$8.85 per hour.

<u>Tipped employees</u>: State law does not allow a lower wage for tipped employees. They must be paid at least the minimum wage per hour, plus any tips earned by the employee.
