SafeSend Returns: User Tips

Now that we've been electronically delivering completed tax returns via SafeSend Returns, we wanted to provide some tips to make the process as easy as possible for our clients.

Remember - for those *married filing jointly*, the return will be delivered FIRST to the spouse listed as the taxpayer. After signing, the return will be delivered to the spouse.

#1: Whitelist our sending email address

Make sure to whitelist the email address <u>noreply@safesendreturns.com</u> (and check your spam/junk folder often). This is the email address your completed tax return will be delivered to you from.

#2: Opt in to receive a text message when your return is ready

Contact our office and request to receive text messages to alert you when your return is ready for viewing. You will also receive requested access codes via text to make accessing your return easier.

#3: Easily forward K-1's electronically (for returns with K-1's)

While navigating through your return, distribute K-1's by typing in each recipient's email address. You will be able to see when the recipient downloads, and even resend if necessary. These email addresses will hold year over year.

#4: Save the link to access your return

By saving this link, you can securely forward a copy of your return when requested by your banker or financial advisor. When you need to do this, open the link, go through the process to receive your access code, and click the "forward" button.
